• EVE QUICK FOR HEADACHE is a drug product designed to work effectively on headaches. This medication contains ibuprofen, an analgesic agent, combined with allylisopropylacetylurea and anhydrous caffeine, which enhance the analgesic effect, and magnesium oxide which protects the gastric mucosa and accelerates ibuprofen absorption.

<<Product Features>>

- Its unique formulation accelerates absorption of the analgesic agent, and therefore this medication quickly exerts an excellent effect on headaches.
- This combination product is gentle on the stomach, containing the gastric mucosal protective agent.

▲Precautions for Use



If you do not follow the precautions exactly as listed below, your current symptoms may worsen and you may be placed at increased risk of side effects or the risk of having some accidents.

- The following persons must not take this medication:
 - (1) Persons who have had an allergic reaction to any of the ingredients of EVE QUICK FOR HEADACHE.(2) Persons who have experienced asthma after taking this medication or after taking other antipyretic-
- (2) Persons who have experienced asthma after taking this medication o analgesics or common cold medications.
 - (3) Children under 15 years of age.
 - (4) Pregnant women whose due date is within 12 weeks ahead.
- Do not take any of the following medications during the period of taking EVE QUICK FOR HEADACHE:

Other antipyretic-analgesics, common cold medications, sedatives, and motion sickness medications

- Do not operate vehicles or machinery after taking this medication.
 - (Sleepiness or such may occur.)
- This medication must not be taken soon before or soon after alcohol intake.
- Do not use this medication for a long and continuing period.

Consultation

- The following persons should consult a physician, dentist, pharmacist, or registered salesperson before taking this medication:
 - (1) Persons who are receiving any treatment from a physician or dentist.
 - (2) Women who are or may be pregnant.
 - (3) Breast-feeding women.
 - (4) Elderly persons.
 - (5) Persons who have had any allergic reactions to drugs or other substances.
 - (6) Persons who have received a diagnosis of any of the following diseases: Heart diseases, kidney

diseases, liver diseases, systemic lupus erythematosus, mixed connective tissue disease

- (7) Persons who have had any of the following diseases: Gastroduodenal ulcers, ulcerative colitis, Crohn's disease
- If any of the symptoms listed below develop after taking EVE QUICK FOR HEADACHE, they might be side effects of the medication. Stop taking this medication immediately and consult a physician, dentist, pharmacist, or registered salesperson, presenting this leaflet.

- Relief of chills and fever
- Dosage and Administration

Ingr in a Take a dose of EVE QUICK FOR HEADACHE, according to the table below, with cold or lukewarm water, up to 3 times daily. Each dose should not be taken on an empty stomach whenever possible. There must be an interval of at least 4 hours between doses.
